We recognize that those in inner cities who are suffering from addiction may face unique obstacles to recovery, including homelessness, mental illness, criminal convictions, hunger, comorbidities, and a lack of essential support. To address these additional needs, CMDS partners with nonprofit organizations to offer crucial support, including:

New Life Evangelical Baptist Church

Provides social and church programs, transportation, and day care for patients.



Turning Point Clinic

Offers medication assisted treatment, including methadone and suboxone. We provide mental health therapy and medication management to patients with co-occurring disorders. We also provide intensive outpatient treatment with an ecumenical and spiritual focus.



New Life Food Pantry

CMDS believes that the fulfillment of a patient's physiological needs is essential to allowing patients to more fully focus on recovery. To assist with that mission, we established partnerships with the New Life Food Pantry (NLFP) and Turning Point Clinic to offer food to both patients and the food-insecure community of East Baltimore, where there are no area farmers markets or chain grocery stores. NLFP serves Turning Point patients three hot meals daily and offers several food programs to needy area residents, including emergency food boxes, food bags, and weekly community markets which feature fresh produce, meat, dairy, and other food donated by the Maryland Food Bank. In 2018, the New Life Food Pantry received and distributed more than 500,000 lbs. of food and drink to the homeless, very low-income residents, senior citizens, veterans living in group homes, patients at Turning Point Clinic, and others.
